

YTCC Call for Papers

The *American Journal of Public Health (AJPH)*, in collaboration with the Youth Tobacco Cessation Collaborative (YTCC), is planning a theme issue on tobacco cessation amongst young adults aged 18-24. The involved editors are soliciting Research Briefs (80-word unstructured abstract, 800-word text, up to 2 tables/figures) and Research Articles (180-word structured abstract, 3500-word text, up to 4 tables/figures) to be included in this theme issue. All papers will undergo editorial review and be selected for possible peer review by the formal *AJPH* editorial team, as per *AJPH* policy. To be given every possible consideration for inclusion in this theme issue, papers ought to be formally submitted by September 1, 2006, using the *AJPH* online submission system at <http://submit.ajph.org>.
